ELIGIBILITY FOR SUPPORT FROM THE HEALTH EDUCATION AND TRAINING INSTITUTE – RURAL PORTFOLIO

Geographic location

In order to be eligible for programs or support offered by HETI Rural Portfolio, you must work in rural or remote areas of NSW, specifically:

Anywhere in the rural Local Health Districts/Health Organisations:

- Far West NSW
- Southern NSW
- Northern NSW
- Mid North Coast
- Western NSW
- Murrumbidgee
- Hunter New England; Maitland and points north only
- South East Sydney Illawarra; Nowra and points south only
- NSW Ambulance (rural areas)
- Justice Health (rural NSW areas)

Employment status

HETI Rural Portfolio coordinates a range of programs and these have varying eligibility requirements. Please check these requirements for each program in the respective application form and contact us if you are unsure if you qualify.

Current program eligibility

You must be a permanent employee of NSW Health (includes employees of Justice Health and the Ambulance Service of NSW, who work in the geographic areas described above) to apply for the:

- Rural Research Capacity Building Program
- Rural and Remote Scholarship Program
- Management and Leadership Essentials Program

The Clinical Team Leadership Program requires linking permanent Local Health District staff with a GP VMO in a ‘team partnership’ within their town (which meets geographic areas described above).
