Albury Wodonga Health (AWH) is the primary health service for the provincial cities of Albury and Wodonga and a regional referral service for northeast Victoria and Southern NSW.

The health service was created in July 2009, with the amalgamation of Wodonga Regional Health Service and Albury Base Hospital, to become the only cross-border health service in Australia.

FAQ's

Q: Will I be paid overtime?

A: Yes! All un-rostered overtime for Interns and HMOs needs pre-approval, but if you follow the correct procedure you will be paid for overtime worked.

AWH provides a comprehensive range of acute, sub-acute, mental health, ambulatory, community and primary health services for its catchment population of more than 250,000.

AWH is the largest regional health service in Victoria outside Geelong, with more than 64,000 emergency department presentations, 39,000 inpatient episodes and 1600 births per year.



Q: Do I have to work nights?

A: No! Interns are not required to work overnight on the ward. Rostered weekend and evening shifts on the ward finish at 2200. HMO's (PGY2+) are required to work nights in some rotations (ED and Ward Cover).
