The Rural Medical Trainee Scholarship application is now online!

Scholarships of up to \$4,500 are now available to provide financial assistance with course fees, travel, accommodation and other expenses directly associated with the education and training needs of rurally-based medical trainees.

Education and training registration fees, travel, accommodation and other directly-incurred expenses may be eligible for support.

ELIGIBILITY

In order to qualify for the scholarship, applicants must be:

- Accessing a CPD activity that is:
 1. Requiring travel of a distance greater than 150 kilometres from current locality or;
 2. Transitioned to an online platform due to COVID-19 and;
- An Australian or New Zealand citizen or permanent resident and;
- Currently employed as medical trainee (full-time or part-time) under the Public Hospital Medical Officers Award and;
- Based in a NSW Health rural hospital site (MMM3-MMM7) with a contract of nine months or greater and;
- Supported by their Network Director of Training or Line Manager.
