## Allied Health Leadership Learning Pathway

### Module – Allied Health: Lead and Influence

This foundational module supports Allied Health clinicians to recognise and grow the skills needed to influence and create positive change in healthcare. It builds confidence and understanding of your ability to contribute meaningfully across teams and services in NSW Health.

#### Video 1 - What Is leadership?

Professor Joanne Travaglia explores why effective leadership is essential for delivering high-quality healthcare. This video highlights key findings from global research and inquiries and introduces the different levels and types of leadership across the health system.

#### Video 2 - Why is leadership important in healthcare?

Professor Travaglia discusses why we need an allied health perspective in health leadership. The specific challenges for allied health leaders and the unique contribution of allied health to health systems leadership.

#### Video 3 – What do we know about allied health leadership?

Professor Travaglia explores allied health leadership through the lens of systems leadership, responding to the complexity and understanding collective leadership.

#### Video 4 – Looking at allied health leadership through the lens of a systems leadership

Professor Travaglia identifies what makes allied health leadership different and the unique contribution of allied health leadership to the health system.

#### Video 5 – Allied health leaders' knowledge and skills

Professor Travaglia discusses what the allied health leader needs to know - strategic thinking, intersectionality and patient/person-centred care.
