**Emergency Medicine Registrar** - This is an exciting opportunity to train in Emergency Medicine in a large regional ED with a wide variety of high acuity clinical presentations, well supported by a team of FACEMS dedicated to trainee education. The position would suit a motivated and enthusiastic ACEM trainee, ACRRM trainee or a PGY4+ medical officer with an interest in rural emergency medicine.

- Regional ED with 40,000 presentations per year including about 10,000 paediatric. 45% admission rate for adults, 25% for paed
- Wide range of clinical presentations including interesting and challenging trauma and rural emergencies unique to the region
- Well-staffed with on 2 on-site FACEMs from 8 am to midnight and on-call FACEM overnight
