METROPOLITAN ACCESS SCHOLARSHIP (MAS)

Information for Rural Trainees

2020/21 FINANCIAL YEAR APPLICATIONS NOW OPEN

Are you a medical trainee working in a rural hospital?

Will you be required to relocate to an outer metropolitan or metropolitan hospital as part of your training?

If so, you may be eligible for MAS.

MAS is a grant provided to rural trainees to assist with:

- Travel and relocation costs
- Rental assistance
- Living expenses

ELIGIBILITY

- ✓ Australian/New Zealand citizens and permanent residents
- ✓ NSW Health employees
- ✓ Rural-based vocational, non-specialist doctors (SRMOs and trainees working in unaccredited training positions) and prevocational trainees
- ✓ Relocating from your primary rural location to undertake outer metropolitan or metropolitan training terms and incurring travel and accommodation costs in the 2020/21 clinical year.
- ✓ Reference letter from your current supervisor/mentor at your primary rural location in your application.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Each scholarship is valued at a maximum of \$12,000 provided pro rata based on the number of weeks of the placement.
