

Radiology Phase 1 Anatomy Exam Preparation Course

ABOUT

The Health Education and Training Institute presents an examination preparation course for Radiology Trainees preparing to sit the RANZCR Anatomy Phase 1 exam on Thursday, 9 April 2026.

The course runs over two weekends and will focus on exam preparation techniques and targeted revision of anatomy using RANZCR exam-style practice questions (image-based structure identifications, MCQs, VSAQs and SAQs). Participants will engage in individual and team exercises followed by feedback and targeted revision of regional anatomy, including Head and Neck, Thorax, Abdomen, Pelvis and Limb anatomy.

The course is recommended for participants who have already done independent study/revision and want to practice answering questions in a format like the exam.

Participants will need a word processing app on their computers/laptops/tablets.
