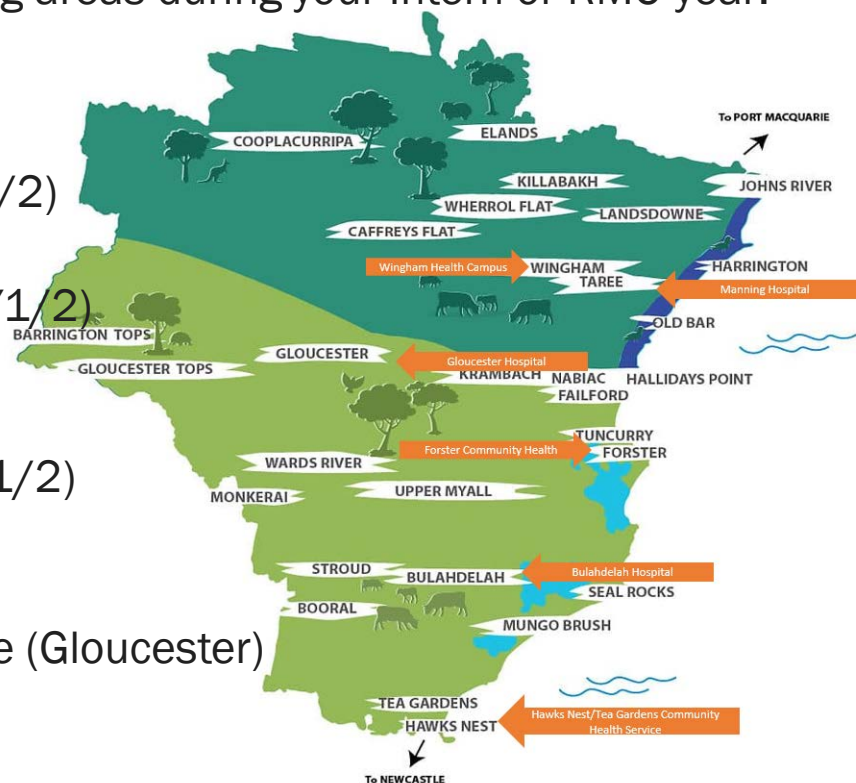


# ABOUT US

**Q: Will I be required to work night shifts as an intern?**

**A:** During your Intern year whilst on your Emergency term you will not be rostered for nights until week 5 or after. All other terms are day shift only.



**Q: Will I be paid for overtime?**

**A:** Un-rostered overtime is paid upon validation of the overtime claim via Medical Admin. Rostered overtime is offered from time to time and will be paid to you within the same pay period it is offered.



**Q: How about incentives?**

**A:** FREE shared Hospital accommodation for PGY1s and incentives offered for PGY2 upon discussion. Please liaise with the JMO Manager for further information.
