ELECTRONIC POSTERS (EPOSTER)

An ePoster replicates in many ways the traditional conference poster presentation, providing a way to share your work without an oral presentation.

Selected ePosters will be displayed during allocated time slots throughout the forum. This guide is to assist you in creating your ePoster.

FORMAT AND LAYOUT GUIDELINES

As the Connections Forum is utilising virtual meeting room technology, to optimise electronic transmission ePosters must resemble a traditional PowerPoint slide show. Simplicity is essential to ensure visual clarity for forum participants.

All ePosters MUST:

- Address the forum theme 'Together We Are Stronger'
- Be in Microsoft PowerPoint format
- Be limited to a maximum of six (6) slides per ePoster
- Follow the suggested time allocation of five (5) minutes air-time per ePoster (i.e. each slide will display for about 20 seconds)

Suggested layout:

- Slide 1 - Title
- Slide 2 - Background
- Slide 3 - Approach
- Slide 4 - Outcome/results
- Slide 5 - Key take home message
- Slide 6 - Contact details

SLIDE DESIGN

- Be culturally respectful
- Each slide should illustrate a single point or idea
- Use large font to maximise readability

- Do not crowd the slide
- Use no more than seven (7) lines, seven (7) words per line
- Use either light colours (e.g. white, yellow) on a dark background, OR use dark colours (e.g. black, dark blue, dark green) on a light background
- Use your organisation's logo on the first slide only
- Use simple graphs rather than tables if possible
- Slides MUST NOT contain dynamic visual elements such as:
 - Embedded videos
 - Scrolling text
 - Complex graphs
 - Animation
 - 3D rotation
 - Hyperlinks
- All ePosters will be reviewed to ensure audio visual clarity and compatibility to ensure optimal transmission.
