ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Rural Medical Trainee Scholarship application is now online!

Scholarships of up to \$4,500 are now available to provide financial assistance with course fees, travel, accommodation and other expenses directly associated with the education and training needs of rurally-based medical trainees.

Education and training registration fees, travel, accommodation and other directly-incurred expenses may be eligible for support.

ELIGIBILITY

To qualify for the scholarship, applicants must be:

- Accessing a CPD activity that is relevant to their training and is completed between 1 July 2022 and 30 June 2023
- An Australian or New Zealand citizen or permanent resident and;
- In attendance of CPD activities while based in a NSW Health rural hospital site (MMM3-7) with a contract of nine months or greater and;
- Employed as medical trainee (full-time or part-time) under the NSW Health Public Hospital Medical Officers (State) Award and;
- Supported by their Network Director of Training or Line Manager.
