

Becoming a Psychiatry Trainee

New South Wales | 2026–27

Application process

Applications to commence psychiatry training follow a two-step selection process. Applicants must submit separate applications with the RANZCP Fellowship Training Program and to a College-accredited psychiatry training position with NSW Health.

Apply to the RANZCP Fellowship Training Program:

Apply to NSW Health:
