PEOPLE MANAGEMENT SKILLS PROGRAM - COHORT 5

The People Management Skills Program (PMSP) offers an integrated approach to effectively support teams, build management capability, and positively manage challenging situations.

The program dives into management processes including critical analysis, strategic thinking, communication skills, and understanding engagement and wellbeing. The six interactive virtual modules focus on strong participant engagement and practical skill development for immediate application in the workplace. The content is highly engaging, visually stimulating and participants are supported with an interactive resource toolkit.

PMSP continues to grow year on year, with nearly 1000 participants enrolling in 2022. Strong representation from Nursing and Midwifery staff is evident, making up 25% of all PMSP participation.

Participants can choose from a range of flexible options to accommodate their needs and schedule. The program is open to all NSW Health organisations and targeted toward health managers or staff acting in a role with people management responsibilities.

STILL AVAILABLE - FULLY FUNDED SCHOLARSHIPS FOR APPLIED MENTAL HEALTH STUDIES ADULT SPECIALISATION

The NSW Health Mental Health Branch has partnered with the Health Education and Training Institute (HETI) Mental Health Portfolio to offer fully funded postgraduate mental health scholarships which support workforce capabilities within NSW Health Services. Ten scholarships have been awarded to date. The scholarship is open until all have been awarded.

This first time offering of the scholarship will enable students to complete a full degree level within the qualification of Applied Mental Health Studies (AMHS) course Adult Mental Health Specialisation. AMHS units are offered completely online over a five-week teaching period. They are designed with flexibility to meet the needs of the health workforce who are combining study with other commitments. Scholarships will support students to complete a degree level across a maximum of three years.

Scholarship recipients won't be required to pay a fee and students must complete their degree by the end of 2025.

STRENGTHENING FOUNDATIONS ORIENTATION FACE 2 FACE WORKSHOP



The Strengthening Foundations workshop supports the orientation of new staff commencing in the Aboriginal Maternal Infant Health Service (AMIHS) and Building Strong Foundations (BSF) service facilitated by the Training Support Unit (TSU). The purpose of this workshop is to assist in developing a broader understanding of Aboriginal social and emotional health and wellbeing along with the principles of primary health care, strengths-based practice, care models, professional wellbeing and teamwork. The strengthening foundations workshop is part of the professional development program for onboarding the multidisciplinary workforce working with Aboriginal mothers, families and communities in AMIHS and BSF services.

The Strengthening Foundations Face to Face workshop will be held on Tuesday 14 and Wednesday 15 February 2023 and facilitated by the TSU in Sydney. This event has NSW staff coming together from across NSW for the first time for this workshop since the global COVID 19 pandemic.

The TSU will deliver a further Strengthening Foundations workshop in June 2023 for new staff joining AMIHS and BSF.
