

Rural Medical Trainee Scholarship

Supporting NSW Health Medical Trainees
working in rural or remote areas

APPLICATIONS OPEN: Thursday 28 March 2024 – Monday 22 April 2024

About the program

The Rural Medical Trainee Scholarship is available to rural-based NSW Health medical trainees, offering financial assistance for expenses related to accessing continuing professional development (CPD) activities.

Scholarships of up to \$3,000 are provided to support the cost of course fees, travel, accommodation and other expenses directly associated with the education and training needs of medical trainees based in rural areas.

Eligibility

To qualify for the scholarship, applicants must be:

- Accessing a CPD activity that is relevant to their training and is completed between 1 July 2023 and 30 June 2024;
- In attendance of CPD activities while based in a NSW Health rural hospital site (MMM3-7) with a contract of nine months or greater;
- Employed as a medical trainee (full-time or part-time) under the NSW Health Public Hospital Medical Officers (State) Award; and
- Supported by their Network Director of Training or Line Manager.
