The Wound Closure Education Program has been specifically designed for nurses who provide care and treatment for patients in the emergency care setting. The program supports the development of knowledge and skills to enable nurses to provide assessment and closure of minor wounds.

The Wound Closure Education Program includes the eLearning module, local face-to-face workshop and capability assessment.

The aim of the program is for you to be able to:

- Perform a wound assessment and identify the most appropriate wound closure technique.
- Demonstrate wound irrigation and closure techniques, including the use of local anaesthetics, tissue adhesive, staples and sutures.
- Document findings of wound assessment and wound closure techniques.
- Provide patients, carers and families with education following wound closure.
