


How to find eLearning modules in My Health Learning including:

Please note: students are not given access to any other eMR or eMeds training modules in My Health Learning

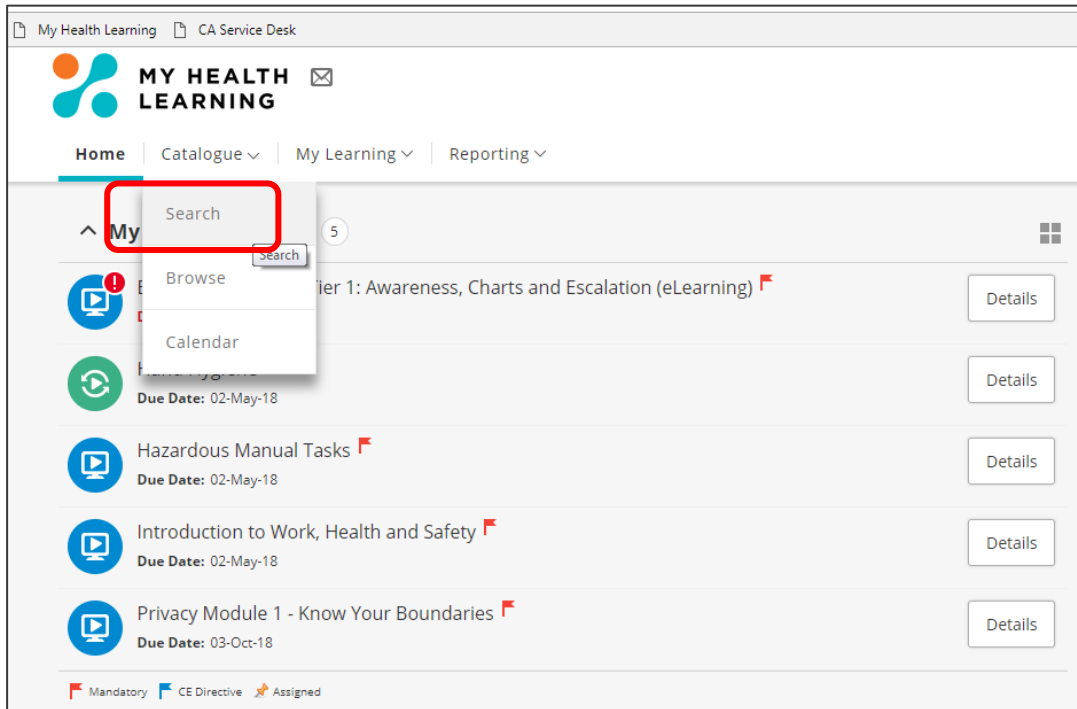
Finding the module

1. Log into My Health Learning (<http://myhealthlearning.health.nsw.gov.au>)
2. When you first login, you will land on this screen and see 5 modules. (If you are a NSW Health employee, you will likely have access to other modules too).

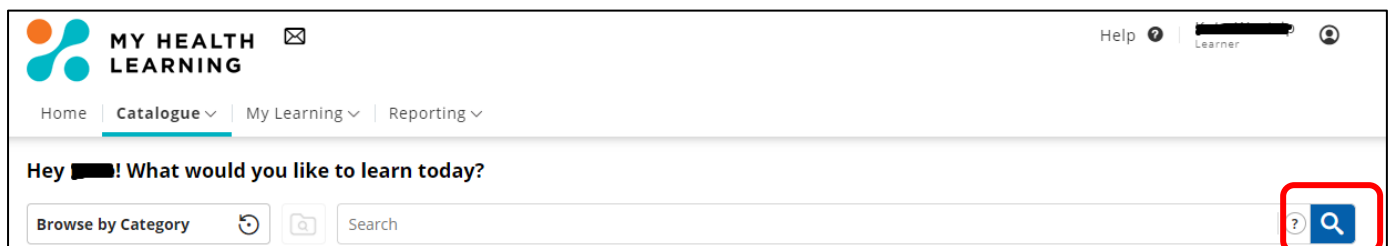

4. On the search Catalogue page, you can either click the **Search** button to show all modules you have access to or type in 'eMR'.




5. Once the modules have been displayed, click **Enrol** and then **Course Details**.
