

How do you recognise and treat maternal sepsis?

Maternal sepsis is a life-threatening condition that can happen at any time during pregnancy, childbirth or in the postnatal period. Recognising and treating maternal sepsis as a medical emergency using the Maternal Sepsis Pathway can save lives.

Through the use of scenarios, job aids and practice activities, this module helps you to apply your understanding of:

- normal physiological changes during pregnancy and how these changes can mask early signs of maternal sepsis
- using the Maternal Sepsis
 Pathway to recognise, resuscitate and escalate maternal sepsis
- the impact of human factors on recognition and management of maternal sepsis.
