

Can you recognise and respond to postpartum haemorrhage, uterine inversion or maternal collapse?

Postpartum haemorrhage, uterine inversion and maternal collapse are maternity emergencies that can lead to a woman rapidly deteriorating. Understanding the physiology behind these emergencies and knowing how to respond can improve outcomes for mothers and babies.
