Deliver inclusive, person-centred services to people with intellectual disability





The Council for Intellectual Disability (CID), a disability rights organisation led by people with intellectual disability, has developed a series of nine (9) eLearning modules designed for health professionals to support inclusive healthcare. The suite of modules titled `Just Include me-Inclusive Health Care' shine the light on person-centred care for people with intellectual disability.

HETI collaborated with the CID to make the modules available on My Health Learning for all NSW Health staff.

The learning pathway aims to:

- Increase the knowledge, skills and confidence of health professionals to work with people with intellectual disability.
- Improve health services and health outcomes for people with intellectual disability, their carers and families.

In line with the recommendations put forward by the Disability Royal Commission, these modules will improve specialist training and continuing professional development in cognitive disability health care.
