About the SSIC

The SSIC has been developed for trainees who are preparing to sit the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons (RACS) Generic Surgical Science Examination.

Surgical Skills Training Network trainees and trainees working in unaccredited surgical training positions are encouraged to register for the SSIC.

Commitment

- The SSIC is a 16-week course that is delivered entirely online. There are no face-to-face lectures to attend.
- Approximately 6-hours per week is required to review online resources.
- Every third week of the program is a 'no content' week and serves as a catch-up week for busy participants.

Course Outline

The course will include:

- Entry and exit examinations with written feedback on performance.
- An online lecture series of videos recorded by Subject Matter Experts in the subject areas of: Pathology, Genetics, Physiology, Microbiology, Histology, Haematology, Radiology, Pharmacology and Embryology.
- Practice exam questions every 3 weeks.
- A two-day virtual Anatomy Workshop delivered by University Biomedical Sciences Anatomists in September 2026.
- An extensive library of anatomy videos.
